WHERE/WHEN DO I GET AN INSTRUMENT?

There are two ways to acquire an instrument for band. We offer an Instrument Rental Night in Bellingham High School auditorium on Wednesday September 6th, 2017, which is the same night as our Band Orientation. We also have school-owned instruments that we loan to students (first priority will be given to students enrolled in free or reduced lunch).

STUDENT-PARENT-MUSIC DEPARTMENT AGREEMENT

Each student will be expected to:

1. Study for at least one half year (September to after winter concert in December) unless the instructor recommends termination of instruction through parental consultation.
2. Attend each lesson prepared with instrument, music binder, and method book.
3. Play the instrument 4-5 nights per week, 20 minutes a night. The teacher may be contacted to discuss a student's progress at any time.
4. Purchase or rent the best possible instrument. Beware of low prices or second hand instruments. Poor instruments frustrate beginners and hinder learning. School instruments are available AT NO CHARGE to those who need one. Preference will be given to students on free or reduced-cost lunch.
5. PLEASE do not handle the instrument until the student receives proper instruction at the first lesson.
6. Read the 5th Grade Band Handbook.
7. Accept responsibility for the care and maintenance of the instrument.
